## Patrick Malone, S. J.

Jesuit Father Patrick Malone has a rich pastoral history. He comes to us from the Dominican Republic, where he is the director of the pastoral program for the Institute for Latin American Concerns, a program serving rural families.

Father Malone is a priest with the Wisconsin Province of the Society of Jesus. He served as an associate pastor at St. Luke and at Macalester College, St. Paul. He was the director of St. Stephen's Homeless Shelter in Minneapolis. He served as a Peace Corps volunteer in Mali, Africa, and ministered at Ground Zero after 9-11.

Handmade items from the Dominican Republic will be available for purchase. Proceeds will be used for a free school for Haitian refugee children.
